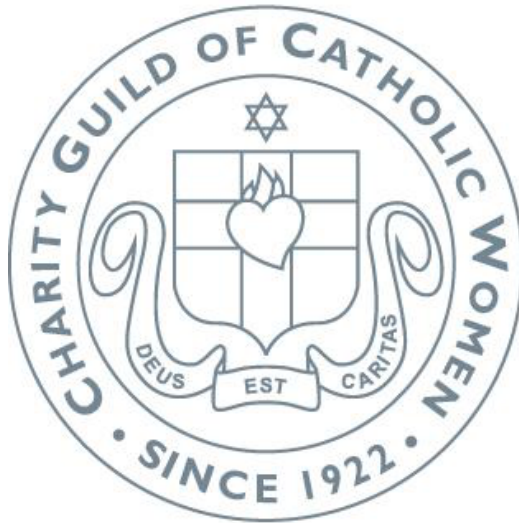
THE MEMORARE

Technology and Charity Guild How To:

How do I get onto our website?

Go to www.charityguildshop.org. To get information that is provided to members only, click on “**Members**” located at the top of the homepage. You will be asked for a password to view that section. The password is Cg1922 (Note that this password is case sensitive and that the “C” must be a capital letter and the “g” must be lower case).

How do I change my contact information in the directory?

Go to the **Member** section of our website. Scroll down the page to Group Emails. Go to Changes and click on the word. If you have email set up on your computer, an email will pop up and you can type the changes and send the email. Alternatively, you can just send an email to changes@charityguildshop.org.

Where do I get an application for a new Provisional?

Applications are found in the Scanlan Room near the statue of Mary. Alternatively, you may download the packet from the website. Go to the Members page, scroll down the left side of the page and click on New Provisional Application Information.

How can I make a donation?

Donation forms are located in numerous places. You will find one in your yearbook, last page. You can go to our website and click on Donate at the top of the homepage. You may donate online or use the link on that page to download a Donation form if you do not wish to donate online.. There are also donation forms in the Finance office.

Where do I find an updated copy of our Bylaws?

Go to the **Members** page of our website. Scroll down and on the left side of the page find Bylaws. Click on Bylaws.

How do I request a room reservation at the Shop for a committee meeting?

Go to the **Members** page of the website. Scroll down the left side of the page and click on Room Reservation. Then you will scroll down the page and see the Room Reservation Calendar. After the calendar there is a place to request the room online. Fill out the form and click on the **Submit** button.

How do I download the Church Directory app?

The directory portion of Charity Guild of Catholic Women Yearbook is available via the Instant Church Directory app and online at

- After downloading the app, simply open it and you will be prompted to type in your email address and select a password.
 - The email address you type in **MUST** be the same email that is in the directory.
 - Select a password, and write down the password if you are likely to forget it.
- The same password is good on all of your devices.
- Please note sequence of searchable information:
 - Last Name is at top
 - Next lines have Title First Name (Nickname) Maiden Name (Spouse) Zip Code, Parish, Provisional Year, Status, Birthday, Work Day (-DM appended if Day Manager)
